

How Can I Be Saved?

The LORD said, "I have surely seen the affliction of my people who are in Egypt, and have heard their cry because of their taskmasters, for I know their sorrows. I have come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land to a good and large land, to a land flowing with milk and honey; Exodus 3:7-8

He (Jesus) was despised and rejected by men, a man of suffering and acquainted with disease. Isaiah 53:3

But he (Jesus) was pierced for our transgressions. He was crushed for our iniquities. The punishment that brought our peace was on him; and by his wounds we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray. Everyone has turned to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him (Jesus) the iniquity (sin) of us all. Isaiah 53:5-6

God asks that you turn to Him with your whole heart and receive His free gift of salvation from sin so that you can be forgiven, be born again by His Holy Spirit living in you and spend eternity with Him in heaven. Whoever calls on the name of the Lord Jesus will be saved (Rom. 10:13). We are saved by grace through faith, not our own good works (Eph. 2:8-9). If you refuse His offer of salvation, there is a weight of sin upon you that you will bear for all eternity in hell, being in torment and separated from Him forever.

if you will confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father, except through me." John 14:6

Pray out loud in the sincerity of your heart: Heavenly Father, thank You for revealing the truth to me. I confess that I am a sinner who needs to be saved. Thank you for opening my eyes to see that without You I am in a hopeless situation, with a weight of sin and bondage in my life and no power over death. I humble myself before You. I believe that You Jesus paid the penalty for my sins through your suffering and death and rose again to give me life that will last for all eternity. Please forgive my sins. I accept You as my Lord and Savior. Because of Your love for me, I turn from sin and choose to live for You now. Let the power of Your Holy Spirit, who raised Jesus from the dead, now empower me to walk in love with You and with others each day. Thank you for Your salvation! In the name of Jesus I pray, Amen.
